It also contains close to 200 service-specification and service-standard assets mapped to the TRM model and, with Everware's contributions, boasts commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) components and an Everware application-oriented reference model to complement the FEA content. Everware's components have been implemented specifically for government organizations and are mapped to the SRM; example services include Audit History, Global Code and Address. The Everware reference model is a high-level model of a human resources application that illustrates how Everware's pre-built components can be used.

"The FEA Service Component Reference Model, or SRM, provides a classification scheme for service components. By registering metadata for actual enterprise component products in the Logidex Asset Center and mapping them to appropriate SRM objects, we can demonstrate the value of the Federal Enterprise Architecture, as well as the Asset Center, to individual project architects," explains Warren Ellmore, President, Everware. "With Logidex, it's easy for development projects to locate reusable objects that significantly reduce the time and cost of developing solutions."
