Logidex-Driven Community Reporting Provides Open Forum for Customers to Exchange Ideas and Realize Greater Benefits from Reuse and SOA Projects

PITTSBURGH—July 11, 2006—LogicLibrary®, the leader in design-time service-oriented architecture (SOA) governance and software reuse, today announced the launch of Logidex Community Reporting (LCR), a collaboration vehicle to facilitate the rapid and mutual sharing of report designs and ideas in the fast-growing Logidex community. LCR makes it possible for Logidex users to easily share ideas and expertise on how to maximize their software reuse and SOA initiatives.

Logidex Community Reporting was introduced at LogicLibrary's recent Customer Care Conference. Representatives from leading organizations such as LL Bean, Wyeth, TELUS and Liberty Mutual took part in the conference. Via Logidex, LCR provides these companies, and all LogicLibrary customers, with a method to share report designs and find applicable designs submitted by others in the community. LCR is also a forum for users to discuss and express opinions on topics of interest. LCR reports include items such as activity reports on assets created and published, asset reuse requests and assets related to reference models. These items are crucial to effective reuse and SOA projects. Each organization has complete control over how much or how little they participate.

“Open and unfettered collaboration within a community helps all parties produce higher quality solutions,” said Alan Himler, vice president of product marketing and management at LogicLibrary. “Over the years, some of the greatest features in Logidex have been driven by our customers. LCR will open up a community discussion between customers that helps everyone derive even greater benefits from Logidex.”

Logidex Community Reporting is an extension of LogicLibrary's Product Enhancement and Request for Support (PERFS) system. LCR is available to all Logidex customers. Community members can use the forum without input or approval from LogicLibrary. LCR reports are flexible and can be based on a variety of sources, including Business Intelligence and Reporting Tools (BIRT) from the Eclipse Foundation, Crystal and SQL queries.

“Logidex Community Reporting is a great example of how all parties can benefit from increased collaboration,” said Wilbur Hong, senior architect at TELUS, Canada’s leading telecommunications company. “Sharing ideas and experiences in this unique community environment will lead to better solutions for all parties.”

Logidex is a design-time repository/registry with configurable governance policies that make it possible for organizations to actively track and manage services from design through deployment. Logidex is the only design-time product to feature tight integration with the industry’s major development environments, including Eclipse, IBM WebSphere Studio, IBM Rational Application Developer, Software Modeler and Software Architect, Microsoft Visual Studio .NET, BEA Workshop Studio, Borland JBuilder and SAP NetWeaver.

Having the flexibility to move effortlessly between development environments is an important consideration for organizations today. In its Spring 2006 survey of over 1200 developers worldwide, Evans Data Corp. found that “most use 2-3 [IDEs] in their work flow,” (http://evansdata.com/devchoice_ide_scorecard.shtml). Combining Logidex’s industry-leading governance capabilities and tight IDE integration with the community environment created by LCR gives LogicLibrary customers the flexibility and feedback they need to create and manage world-class business solutions.
