*Vice President of Technology Brent Carlson to Serve on
OASIS SOA Adoption Blueprints Committee*

PITTSBURGH—August 30, 2005—LogicLibrary®, the leading provider of software development asset (SDA) management tools, today announced it has become a member of OASIS, the Organization for the Advancement of Structured Information Standards. Brent Carlson, LogicLibrary’s co-founder and vice president of technology, will serve on the OASIS Service-Oriented Architecture (SOA) Adoption Blueprints Technical Committee.

The OASIS SOA Adoption Blueprints Committee will produce a series of vendor- and specification-neutral business requirements designed to guide organizations with their SOA projects. Other members of the Committee include Adobe Systems, Booz Allen Hamilton, Capgemini, Infravio, MW2 Consulting, and Software AG, as well as many end user organizations.

“The successful deployment and advancement of Web services and SOAs, relies on the successful creation and acceptance of a clear set of industry standards,” said Brent Carlson. “OASIS has done an exceptional job in leading the effort to develop these standards. LogicLibrary looks forward to contributing to the important work being done by the OASIS SOA Adoption Blueprints Committee.”
